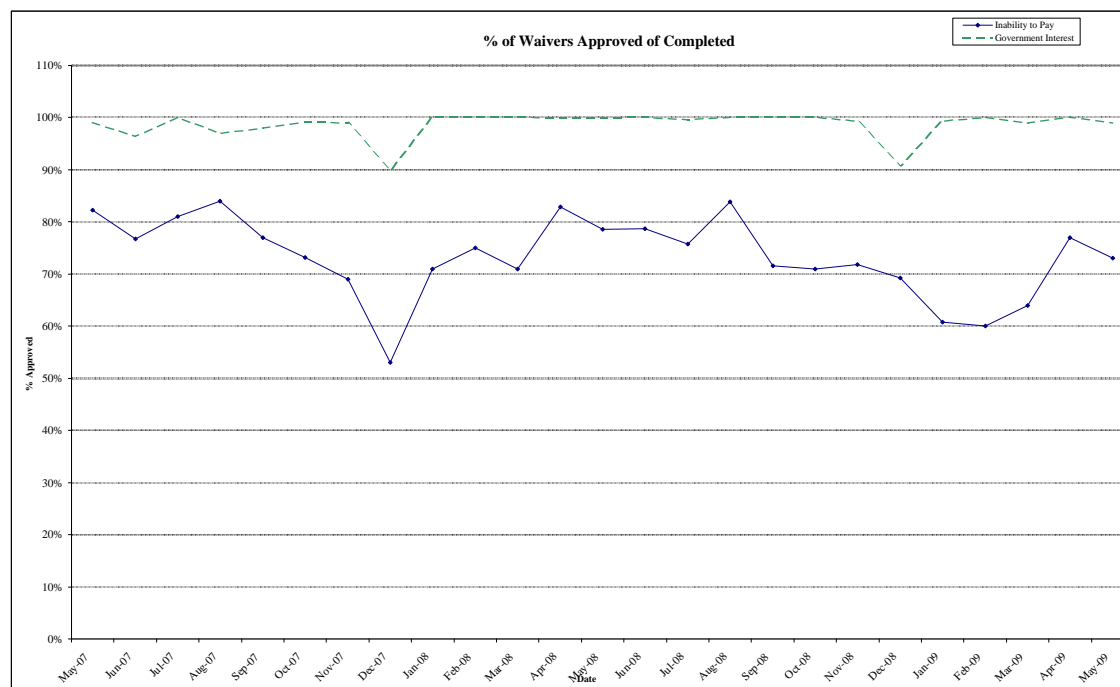
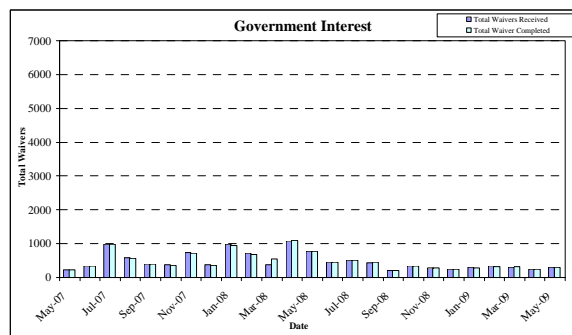
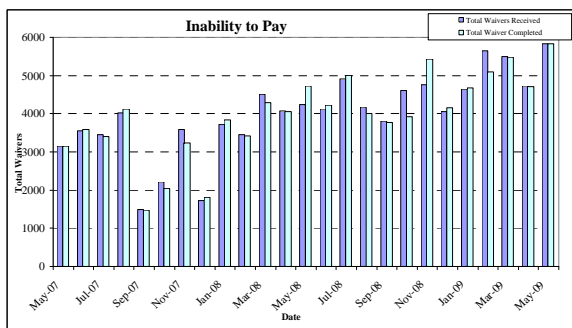

**Inability to Pay Waivers:**

Total Inability to Pay fee waivers received increased by 23% (from 4726 in April 2009 to 5840 in May 09) and total fee waivers approved in May increased by 18% compared to last month. Total fee waivers completed increased by 24% from 4705 in April 09 to 5838 in May 09 in May N-400s accounted for 23% of Servicewide receipts and I-765s accounted for 8% of the Servicewide receipts. Service Centers received 100% of all N-400 fee waivers and 96% of all I-765 fee waivers. Service Center receipts accounted for 98% of Servicewide receipts, reporting 5,728 of the 5,840 Servicewide Total for May 2009.

**Government Interest Waivers:**

During the month of May the total number of Government Interest fee waivers received Servicewide increased by 18%, followed by an increase of 18% in approvals. 3% of all Government Interest waivers received were I-90 fee waivers and 54% were I-765 fee waivers. The Los Angeles Office reported receiving 0% of Servicewide I-765 fee waivers. The New York City Office and the Los Angeles Office combined, accounted for 13% of total Government Interest waivers received. Offices received 93% of Servicewide Government Interest fee waivers.
